1	<u>Anarchy Brewery, Stannington, Northumberland. Blonde Star 4.1 % abv (colour blonde)</u> Lemon, grapefruit & passion fruit hop flavours combine with pale malts to give a crisp & fresh session blonde.
2	<u>Arbour Brewery, Easton, Bristol. Blue Sky Drinking 4.0% abv (colour tawny)</u> Full bodied malty backbone is balanced by delicate citrus notes, not usually associated with English hops, & a clean bitter finish.
3	<u>Bristol Beer Factory, Ashton, Bristol. Milk Stout 4.5 % abv (colour black)</u> Sweet, full – bodied black stout with lactose creaminess. Finishes with Smokey roast bitterness.
4	<u>Burning Sky Brewery, Firle, East Sussex. Summertime 4.5 % abv (colour pale golden)</u> Brewed with Maris Otter & wheat malts, a delicate spicing & blend of classic European & New Zealand hop varieties give a refreshing finish.
5	<u>Cerne Abas, Dorchester, Dorset. Ale 3.8 % abv (colour tawny)</u> A well - balanced tawny – coloured ale with a full mouthfeel & refreshing finish.
6	<u>Cwrw Lal Community Brewery, Mold, Wales. Pothole Porter 5.1 % abv (colour black)</u> Classic style porter. Black + roasted, bursting with British Golding hops.
7	<u>Dark Revolution Brewery, Salisbury, Wiltshire. Nine 2 Five 4.3 % abv (colour golden)</u> Flavours of grassy hops, tangerine & orange. Taste juicy. light sour, light on the malts, with a clean finish.
8	<u>Dark Star Brewery, Partridge Green, West Sussex. Hophead 3.8 % abv (colour golden)</u> A golden – coloured session bitter with a fruity / hoppy aroma & a citrus bitter taste & aftertaste. Flavours remain to the end.
9	<u>Enfield Brewery, Upper Edmonton, London. Speculation 4.8 % abv (colour dark golden)</u> Rich dark malts lead into a complex relationship of hop notes & sweet crystal, giving a rich, smooth & very satisfying drinking experience.
10	<u>Exeter Brewery, Exeter, Devon. Avocet 3.9 % abv (colour gold)</u> Gold coloured bitter that is smooth, fruity & hoppy with a sweet aftertaste. Crisp, light & refreshing.
11	<u>Fixed Wheel Brewery, Blackheath, West Midlands. Wheelie Pale 4.1 % abv (colour pale) Locale</u> Sweet malts with hints of citrus & melon from a combination of Citra, Blanc, Magnum & cardinal hops.
12	<u>Hattie Browns Brewery, Swanage, Dorset. Scarlet 4.5 % abv (colour red)</u> Bright red from adding beetroot to the boil, otherwise it's a well balanced slightly floral & earthy beer,
13	<u>Irving Brewery, Portsmouth, Hampshire. Tin Fish 4.3 % abv (colour burnished gold)</u> Harvest ale brewed with English Challenger Hops for bitterness & aroma, complimented with subtle smooth roasted malt sweetness.
14	<u>Lords Brewery, Golcar, West Yorkshire. Cadillac Outlaw 5.5 % abv (colour pale)</u> Our all new American pale ale in collaboration with Brock Berrigan.
15	<u>Moor Brewery, Days Road, Bristol. So Hop 4.1 % abv (colour ultra pale) Suitable for Vegans (May be hazy)</u> Ultra pale ale balancing rich British floor malt with tropical Southern hemisphere hops.
16	<u>Mourne Mountain Brewery, Northern Island. Clan Rye 4.3 % abv (colour amber)</u> Amber ale brewed with Crystal Rye malts & New Zealand hops.
17	<u>Neepsend Brewery, Sheffield, South Yorkshire. Mosaic 5.5 % abv (colour pale)</u> Big tropical fruit character, grassy hops, berry sweetness & a solid malt base, before a lingering, dryish, finish.
18	<u>New Wharf Brewery, Marlow Road, Maidenhead. Voyage 5.5 % abv (colour amber)</u> Full bodied American ale comprising of 5 different malts & 3 American hops. Hints of caramel & chocolate are tinged with citrus & berry notes.
19	<u>Oakham Brewery, Peterborough, Cambridgeshire. Citra 4.2 % abv (colour pale golden)</u> Refreshing grapefruit & peach aroma & characterise this golden ale. Bittersweet palate gives way to a long, dry aftertaste.
20	<u>Quantock Brewery, Bishops Lydeard, Somerset. Plastered Pheasant 4.8 % abv (colour dark amber)</u> Rich dark amber bitter with a fruity aroma & smooth toffee & coffee flavours
21	<u>Redemption Brewery, Tottenham, London. Hopstur 4.5 % abv (colour amber)</u> Sweet coffee roast notes, a little nuttiness. With resinous hops on the flavour. Dry bitter finish.

22	<u>Salopian Brewery, Hadnall, Shropshire. Shropshire Gold 3.8 % abv (colour copper)</u> Light, copper coloured ale with an unusual blend of body & dryness.
23	<u>Tapstone brewery, Chard, Somerset. Soma 4.6 % abv (colour hazy yellow) Suitable for Vegans (may be hazy)</u> Aroma of hops citrus, grass & tropical fruits. Moderate sweetness, medium bitterness, hint of tartness.
24	<u>Teignmouth Brewery, Newton Abbot, Devon. Templer 4.0 % abv (colour light amber) (New Brewery)</u> _Light amber ale. Light head with sweet floral hints a smooth finish.
25	<u>Totally Brewed Brewery, Nottingham. Slap in The Face 4.0 % abv (colour golden)</u> Golden – coloured ale with citrus fruit hop aroma & taste. Dry bitter finish.
26	<u>Uley Brewery, Gloucestershire. Hogshead Cotswold Pale Ale. 3.5 % abv (colour pale)</u> Hoppy session bitter with a good hop aroma & a full flavour for its strength, ending in a bittersweet aftertaste.
27	<u>Urban Island Brewery Portsmouth, Hampshire. High & Dry 5.5 % abv (colour pale)</u> An American hopped IPA with an earthy base & citrus finish
28	<u>Wiper & True Brewery, St Werburghs, Bristol. Rosalita 4.2 % abv (colour red)</u> Modern take on a traditional red ale. Dry hopped with experimental hops grown in Yakima Valley, bringing a hint of soft fruit & berry alongside tobacco notes to a sweet & spicy malt base Collaboration with Gypsy Hill Brewing Co.
