1	<u>3 D Ales, West Hewish Weston Super Mare Somerset. Fall Out 4.0 % abv (colour bronze gold)</u> Action packed flavour with myriad of hop aromas.
2	<u>Ascot Brewery, Camberley Surrey. Final Furlong 4.2 % abv (colour copper)</u> Sweet malt taste & toffee notes. This is perfectly balanced with the hops providing a sharp bitterness, with a strong citrus & tropical fruit aroma.
3	<u>Ascot Brewery, Camberley Surrey. Anastasia's Stout 5.0 % abv (colour black)</u> Deep & complex stout full of roasted coffee & bitter chocolate flavours with oats to give a smooth mouthfeel. The bitterness is balanced by a silky smooth finish.
4	<u>Aj's, Walsall West Midlands. Stuck in The Dog House 4.7 % abv (colour golden) Locale</u> A traditional English style bitter brewed with locally sourced hops & sweet caramel malts gives this golden ale a well – balanced sweet bitter finish.
5	<u>Beer Mats Brewery, Winkburn Nottinghamshire. Ultimate 4.9 % abv (colour red)</u> This bold full bodied ale is the ultimate drink. Smooth, malty flavours, subtly infused with spices & a sweet honey finish.
6	<u>Beer Mats Brewery, Winkburn Nottinghamshire. Format 3.9 % abv (colour pale)</u> Hoppy finish complemented by a light citrus aroma.
7	<u>Birmingham Brewing Co, Stirchley Birmingham. Bitter Brummie 4.1 % abv (colour amber) LOCALE</u> Brewed from British caramel floor malt with triple hops for bitterness, liquorice & tropical fruit aromas, producing a unique depth & intensity.
8	<u>Colleyfobble Brewery, Barlow Derbyshire. I. P. A 5.2 % abv (colour pale)</u> A traditional Indian Pale Ale.
9	<u>Donkey Stone, Brewery Greenfield Oldham. Bad Ass Blonde 4.1% abv (colour pale)</u> Brewed using some of the oldest UK hops, alongside some modern American varieties.
10	<u>Glastonbury Ales, Somerton. Mystery Tor 3.8 % abv (colour pale golden)</u> Packed with zesty fruity hops to give a refreshing citrus hop flavour. Soft & smooth with a full flavoured body to die for.
11	<u>Old Pie Factory, Warwick. American Pie West Coast Pale. 5.5 % abv (colour golden)</u> Deceptively strong golden ale. The American hops give a subtle, slightly fruity finish.
12	<u>Orkney Brewery, Stromness Orkney. Red Mac Gregor 4.0 % abv (colour tawny red)</u> This tawny red – coloured ale has red fruit, malt & hop mix. Generally a well balanced bitter.
13	<u>Pitchfork Brewery, Weston Super Mare Somerset. Goldbine 3.8 % abv (colour straw gold)</u> A showcase of British hops, bursting with fragrance & flavour.
14	<u>Pitchfork Brewery, Weston Super Mare Somerset. Old Slug Porter 4.5 % abv (colour dark)</u> A traditional porter with a full bodied taste of chocolate, coffee, blackcurrant & black cherry with a good aroma.
15	<u>Salcombe Brewery, Ledstone Devon. Devon Amber 3.8 % abv (colour amber)</u> A classic bitter dry hoppy aroma & flavour with a sweet malt backbone.
16	<u>Sambrooks Brewery, Battersea London. A. P. A 4.2 % abv (colour amber)</u> Our take on an American classic, packed with hops from our American Cousins. This beer is for the hop heads.
17	<u>Salopian Brewery, Hadnall Shropshire. Lemon Dream 4.5 % abv (colour light gold)</u> Brewed with wheat malt & subtly flavoured with lemons.
18	<u>Titanic Brewery, Burslem Stoke on Trent Staffordshire. Plum Porter 4.9 % abv (colour dark brown)</u> Powerful fruity aroma, sweet plum fruitiness gives way to a gentle bitter finish.
19	<u>Twisted Barrel Brewery, Coventry. Beast of a Midlands Mild 3.5 % abv (colour dark)</u> Complex variety of malts provides a rich textured backbone that belies its minimal strength. The addition of vanilla pods Provides a creamy finish & aroma
20	<u>Unity Brewery, Suckley Worcester. Sea Bright Gold 3.8 % abv (colour light amber) LOCALE</u> English ale brewed with famous yeast & Admiral hops. A zesty, spicy quality beer.
21	<u>Weetwood Ales, Kelsall Cheshire. Eastgate 4.2 % abv (colour amber)</u> Well – balanced & refreshing, citrus fruit flavours predominate in taste & there is a short, dry aftertaste.

22	<u>Wily Fox Brewery, Wigan. Crafty Fox 4.0 % abv (colour amber)</u> Full – bodied bitter ale with a spicy, earthy aroma.
23	<u>Swan Brewery, Leominster Herefordshire. Coscoroba 4.5 % abv (colour burnished gold)</u> A touch of sweet spice from crystal rye in the grist is backed up with a bold Calypso & Citra hop notes.
24	<u>Milk Street Brewery, Frome Somerset. Bootleg I P A 4.2 % abv (colour Blonde)</u> <u>Session I P A – big hop flavour.</u>

26	<u>Shiny Brewery, little Eaton Derbyshire. New World Pale 3.7 % abv (colour golden) Vegan</u> A golden citrusy big hitter in terms of flavour that drinks more like a 5% beer. May be hazy.
27	<u>Rock & Roll Brewery, Birmingham. Let England Shake 4.2 % abv (colour pale) Locale Vegan.</u> All English ingredients. May be hazy.
28	<u>Rock & Roll Brewery Birmingham. Kraftwerk Real Lager 5.0 % abv (colour pale) Locale Vegan.</u> Czech hops & German malts & yeast. May be hazy
